Outline of Topics in **EXPLORE** & **EQUIP** module

Topic 1: Inclusive Discipleship

- Scripture references: 1 Corinthians 12, Ephesians 4
- 3Cs of Inclusive Discipleship: it is not just about knowing the Content of God's word, but to practice it through knowing the Lord and having our hearts and Character transformed, as well as living out our faith in Community
- Goal of Inclusion in our Sunday Schools and churches is not to attain gold standard, but to ready our heart posture to receive, welcome, and be ready to enfold and disciple children of ALL abilities in the church community.
- **Existing models of inclusion** in Singapore through testimonies of churches like St James' Church and Seng Kang Methodist Church

Topic 3: Classroom Management

- The church is meant to function in a complementary role to professionals; one does not need to be a therapist to be therapeutic.
- Behavioural strategies are not an end in themselves but are tools that can be used to support children where they are at, meet their needs appropriately, and disciple them.
- Understanding functions of behaviour and how all behaviour is communication (i.e., knowing why a behaviour occurs is the first step to knowing how to address it)
- Understanding behaviour as a chain (i.e., ABC model of behaviour — Antecedent, Behaviour, Consequence) and use of corrective (Consequence-based) strategies to understand triggers, manage unexpected behaviours/meltdowns and increase goal behaviour as well as proactive (Antecedent) strategies to encourage target behaviours and prevent misbehaviour.

Topic 2: Supporting Individual Needs

- Scripture references: Genesis 1:26, Psalm 139, Ephesians 4:7
- Overview of special needs like Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Intellectual Disability (ID) and Specific Learning Disorder (SLD) with an emphasis on Dyslexia
- The goal of understanding disabilities is not to diagnose, but to understand and love better with a focus on their abilities.

Topic 4: Inclusive Lesson Design

- Rethinking norms and behaviour expectations (i.e., concept of a paradigm shift from compliance-based behaviour norms to belonging-focused culture)
- Relooking at a redesigned classroom experience for all with a practical outcome of the ABCs of inclusion — Accessibility, Belonging, Contribution — and how they shape an inclusive Sunday school classroom culture
- Adapting a Bible Study using five adaptations based on the 3Cs of Inclusive Discipleship
